Cittaslow: Kader voor de toekomst met behoud van historie

Sinds 26 juni 2010 is Alphen-Chaam een Cittaslow gemeente. In de Zuid-Koreaanse hoofdstad Seoel ontving burgemeester Harrie Nuijten het certificaat uit handen van Gian Luca Marconi de President van Cittaslow International.

Cittaslow is het internationale keurmerk voor gemeenten (< 50.000 inwoners) die op het gebied van leefomgeving, landschap, streekproducten, gastvrijheid, milieu, infrastructuur, cultuurhistorie en behoud van identiteit tot de top behoren. In een Cittaslow kunnen inwoners en bezoekers op een plezierige, gastvrije manier en op een menselijk tempo genieten. De oorsprong van Cittaslow ligt in Orvieto (Italië).

De kwaliteit van de leefomgeving is het allerbelangrijkst voor een Cittaslow. Dit betekent dat een gezond milieu, het versterken van de landschappelijke kwaliteiten en een goede infrastructuur hoog op de agenda van de gemeente staan. Deze koestert het cultuurhistorisch erfgoed, de plaatselijke tradities en het aanbieden en promoten van streekproducten.

Cittaslow helpt bij het versterken van de bewustwording bij beleidsmakers, instellingen, ondernemers en inwoners. Het keurmerk stimuleert hen om verantwoordelijkheid te nemen voor de ontwikkeling van de gemeente. Voor een authentieke gemeente als Alphen-Chaam belangrijk de lokale identiteit te bewaken, te versterken en verder uit te dragen. Bovendien is het bewustzijn aanwezig dat het gebruik van nieuwe technieken de gewenste vooruitgang mogelijk maakt. Met andere woorden: Cittaslow biedt Alphen-Chaam een kader voor de toekomst met behoud van de historie.

In Alphen-Chaam wordt het Cittaslow-concept ingevuld met een belangrijke culturele component in het kader van Brabantstad Culturele Hoofdstad 2018 (BCH 2018). Centrale vraag daarbij is: 'Hoe kan duurzame plattelandsvernieuwing ook via de inzet van cultuur bijdragen aan duurzame regionale economische ontwikkeling?' Het is duidelijk dat daarbij niet alleen het grondgebied van de gemeente Alphen-Chaam in beeld komt, maar de hele regio tussen de steden Breda en Tilburg en nog daarbuiten.

Cittaslow: A framework for the future while preserving history

Since 26 June 2019 Alphen-Chaam has been a Cittaslow municipality. In Seoul, the capital city of South Korea, Mayor Harrie Nuijten received the certificate from the hands of Gian Luca Marconi, President of Cittaslow International

Cittaslow is the international mark of accreditation for municipalities (< 50,000) that provide the highest quality living environment, local produce, hospitality, natural environment, infrastructure, cultural history and identity preservation. In a Cittaslow, residents and visitors can enjoy life in a pleasant, hospitable way at a human pace. Cittaslow's origins are in Orvieto, Italy.

The quality of the environment is of the utmost importance to a Cittaslow. This means that a healthy environment and the quality of the landscape and infrastructure are high on the local agenda. The local council's mission is to preserve the cultural-historical heritage and to promote regional traditions and local produce.

Cittaslow offers support to strengthen awareness among policy-makers, institutions, entrepreneurs and residents. The Cittaslow accreditation stimulates these participants to take responsibility for developments within the municipality. For an authentic municipality such as Alphen-Chaam it is important to preserve, reinforce and promote local identity. In addition, there is commitment to employing new technologies which will make the desired progress possible. In other words, Cittaslow offers Alphen-Chaam a framework for the future while preserving its history.

In Alphen-Chaam, the Cittaslow philosophy will also be put into practice with a major cultural component within the framework of Brabantstad Culturele Hoofdstad 2018 (BCH 2018). The central leading question is: how can sustainable, partly culture-driven renewal of the countryside contribute to lasting regional economic development? It is self-evident that not only the municipality of Alphen-Chaam will be involved in this process, but the entire region between the cities of Breda and Tilburg, and even beyond.
